PLACEMENT ADVICE

Adding a mirror is like putting a new piece of furniture into a room—surrounding objects may need to shift. Before you commit to a spot, be sure the mirror isn't catching excessive glare from a window or lamp, and that when you walk by you can see as much of yourself as possible (not just your head or, worse, a headless torso). Placing something gorgeous in the mirror's reflection gives added beauty and depth; an empty area creates the illusion of space.
